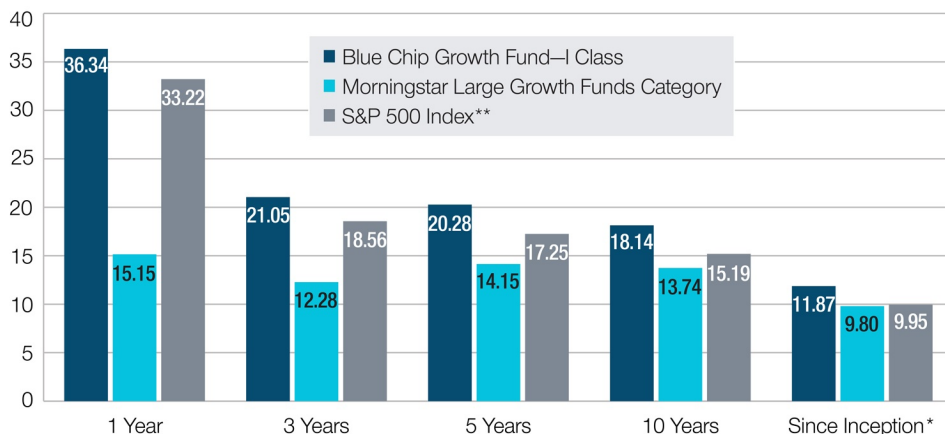

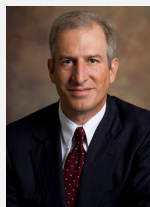

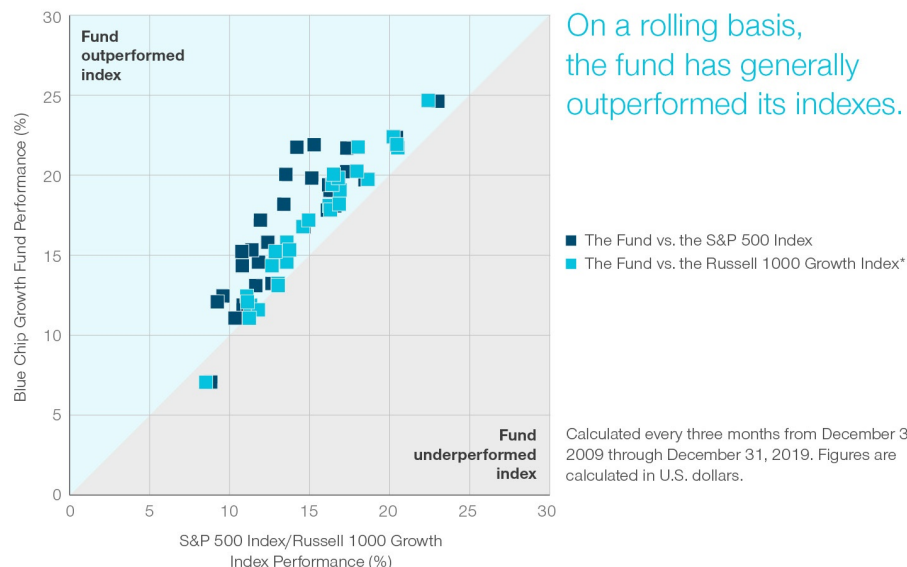

As of 09/30/2020, the Blue Chip Growth Fund - I Class, received 4 stars for 3 Years/1,229 funds, N/A stars for 5 Years/1,095 funds, and N/A stars for 10 Years/813 funds in the Large Growth category. Ratings are subject to change. The Morningstar Rating for funds, or "star rating", is calculated for funds with at least a 3-year history. Exchange-traded funds and open-ended mutual funds are considered a single population for comparative purposes. Three-Year Rolling Returns - Blue Chip Growth Fund (Annualized Net of Fees) vs. S&P 500 and Russell Growth Indexes

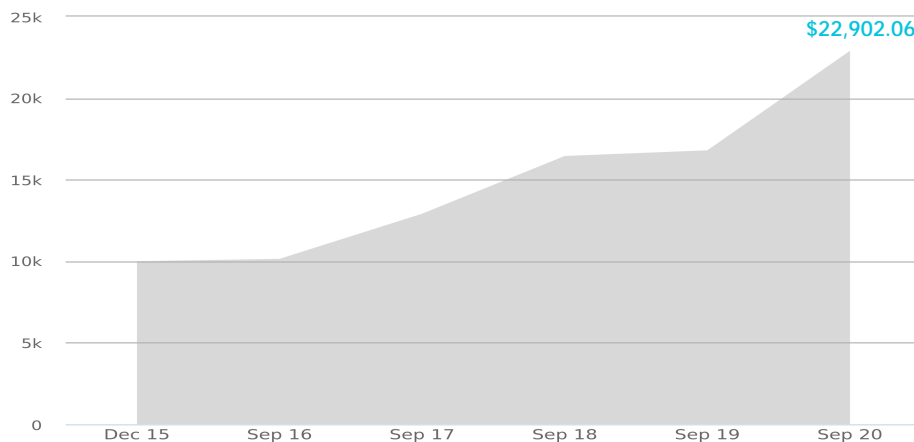


Cumulative Returns
