

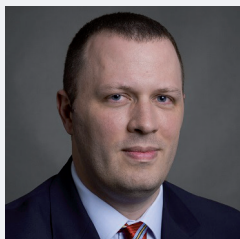

## INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

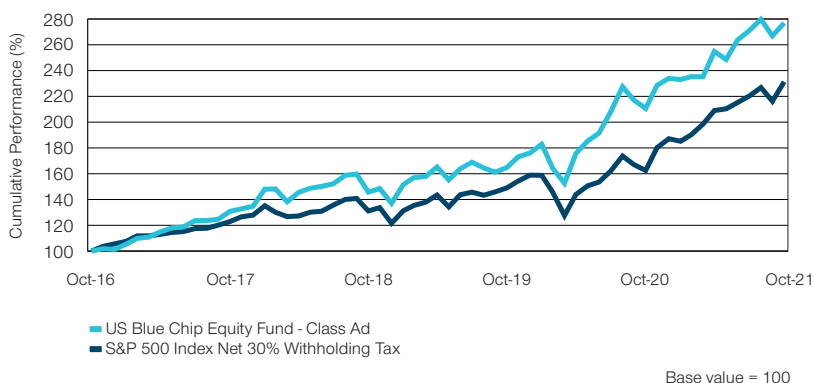
