
Investment Objective & Strategy

The fund seeks to provide current income and capital appreciation.

The fund will normally invest at least 80% of its assets in non-U.S. dollar-denominated bonds. Under normal market conditions the fund will maintain at least 80% of its net assets in U.S. dollar currency exposure.

The fund is actively managed and invests primarily in bonds that are rated investment grade, but may also invest up to 25% of its total assets in bonds that have received a below investment-grade rating from an established credit rating agency, also known as junk bonds.

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Morningstar rated the fund 3 and 3 stars among 103 and 99 Global Bond-USD Hedged funds for the 3- and 5-year periods (as applicable) ending 3/31/2026, respectively. The Morningstar Rating™ for funds, or "star rating", is calculated for funds with at least a three-year history. Exchange-traded funds and open-ended mutual funds are considered a single population for comparative purposes. It is calculated based on a Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a managed product's monthly excess performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. The top 10% of products in each product category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars, and the bottom 10% receive 1 star.

Fund Assets, holdings-based analytics (excluding portfolio turnover), and portfolio attribution are calculated using T. Rowe Price's internal Investment Book of Records (IBOR). Due to timing and accounting methodology differences, IBOR data may differ from the Accounting Book of Records (ABOR) data provided by the Fund's accountant. T. Rowe Price uses a custom structure for sector and industry reporting for this product. Diversification exhibits may not add to 100% due to exclusion or inclusion of cash. Credit ratings for the securities held in the Fund are provided by Moody's, Standard & Poor's and Fitch and are converted to the Standard & Poor's nomenclature. A rating of "AAA" represents the highest-rated securities, and a rating of "D" represents the lowest-rated securities. If the rating agencies differ, the highest rating is applied to the security. If a rating is not available, the security is classified as Not Rated (NR). T. Rowe Price uses the rating of the underlying investment vehicle to determine the creditworthiness of credit default swaps and sovereign securities. The Fund is not rated by any agency. U.S. Government Agency securities, if any, may include conventional pass-through securities and collateralized mortgage obligations. This category may include rated and unrated securities.

Reserves include T-Bills, Cash & Cash Equivalents, etc.
