Investment Objective & Strategy

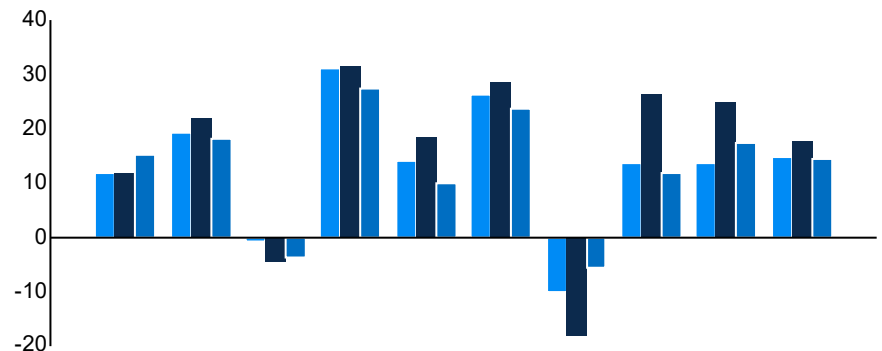
The fund seeks dividend income and long-term capital growth primarily through investments in stocks.

The fund will normally invest at least 65% of its total assets in the common stocks of dividend-paying companies that we expect to increase their dividends over time and also provide long-term appreciation.

- Our in-house research team looks for stocks with sustainable, above-average growth in earnings and dividends, and we attempt to buy them when they are temporarily out of favor or undervalued by the market.

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Morningstar rated the fund 2, 3, and 3 stars among 1,212, 1,122 and 886 Large Blend funds for the 3-, 5-, and 10-year periods (as applicable) ending 3/31/2026, respectively. The Morningstar Rating™ for funds, or "star rating", is calculated for funds with at least a three-year history. Exchange-traded funds and open-ended mutual funds are considered a single population for comparative purposes. It is calculated based on a Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a managed product's monthly excess performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. The top 10% of products in each product category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars, and the bottom 10% receive 1 star.

Rowe Price uses the current MSCI/S&P Global Industry Classification Standard (GICS) for sector and industry reporting.
