## Investment Objective & Strategy

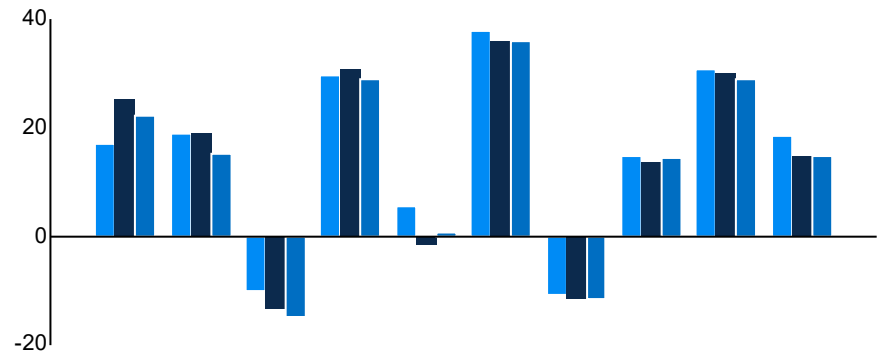
The fund seeks long-term growth of capital and a modest level of income.

Invest at least 80% of net assets in the common stocks of financial services companies. The fund may also invest in companies deriving substantial revenues from conducting business with the industry.

Stock selection is based on fundamental, bottom-up analysis to identify companies with good appreciation prospects. We use both growth and value approaches in selecting investments.

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Morningstar rated the fund 4, 4, and 5 stars among 97, 89 and 73 Financial funds for the 3-, 5-, and 10-year periods (as applicable) ending 3/31/2026, respectively. The Morningstar Rating™ for funds, or "star rating", is calculated for funds with at least a three-year history. Exchange-traded funds and open-ended mutual funds are considered a single population for comparative purposes. It is calculated based on a Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a managed product's monthly excess performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. The top 10% of products in each product category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars, and the bottom 10% receive 1 star.
