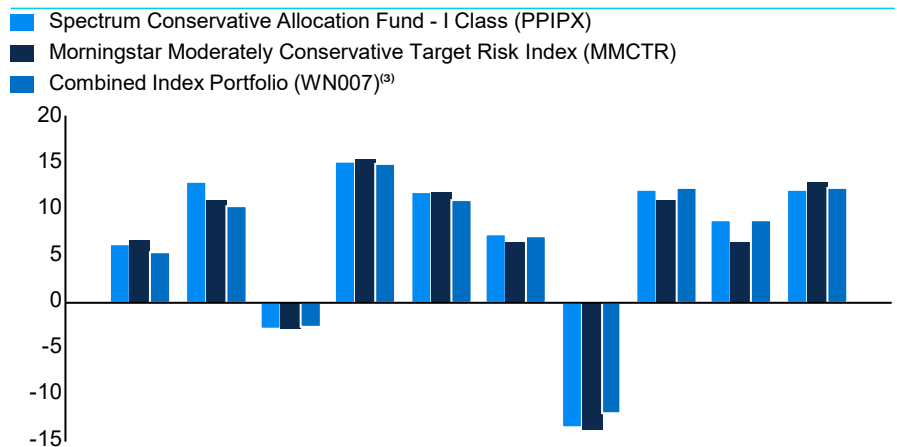

## Investment Objective & Strategy

The fund seeks the highest total return over time consistent with a primary emphasis on income and a secondary emphasis on capital growth. For income and some appreciation, the fund is actively managed and invests in a diversified portfolio typically consisting of about 40% stocks, 55% bonds, money market securities, and cash reserves; and 5% alternative investments. The manager can rebalance the investment mix, within defined ranges, based on the economic outlook, interest rates, and financial markets.

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Morningstar rated the fund 4, 4, and 5 stars among 220, 213 and 178 Global Moderately Conservative Allocation funds for the 3-, 5-, and 10-year periods (as applicable) ending 3/31/2026, respectively. The Morningstar Rating™ for funds, or "star rating", is calculated for funds with at least a three-year history. Exchange-traded funds and open-ended mutual funds are considered a single population for comparative purposes. It is calculated based on a Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a managed product's monthly excess performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. The top 10% of products in each product category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars, and the bottom 10% receive 1 star.

Combined Index Portfolio: As of August 1, 2012 Combined Index Portfolio consisted of 28% Russell 3000 Index, 40% Bloomberg U.S. Aggregate Bond Index, 20% FTSE 3-Month Treasury Bill Index, and 12% MSCI All Country World Ex-U.S. Index Net. From July 1, 2008 until July 31, 2012, the Combined Index Portfolio consisted of a range of 28-32% Russell 3000 Index, 8-12% MSCI All-Country World Ex USA Index Net, 40% Bloomberg U.S. Aggregate Bond Index, and 20% FTSE 3-Month Treasury Bill Index. From Inception until June 30, 2008, the Combined Index Portfolio consisted of a range of 32-34% Wilshire 5000 Index, 6-8% MSCI EAFE Index Net, 40% Bloomberg U.S. Aggregate Bond Index, and 20% FTSE 3-Month Treasury Bill Index.
