## INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND STRATEGY

The fund seeks long-term growth of capital.

The fund normally invests at least 80% of its net assets (including any borrowings for investment purposes) in stocks issued by companies in emerging markets.

The fund expects to make most of its investments in stocks of companies located in, or that have economic ties to, the emerging markets countries (which include frontier markets) in Asia, Latin America, Europe, Africa, and the Middle East.

Stock selection is driven mainly by fundamental research that seeks to identify companies that appear to be undervalued by various measures and may be temporarily out of favor but have good prospects for capital appreciation or dividend growth.

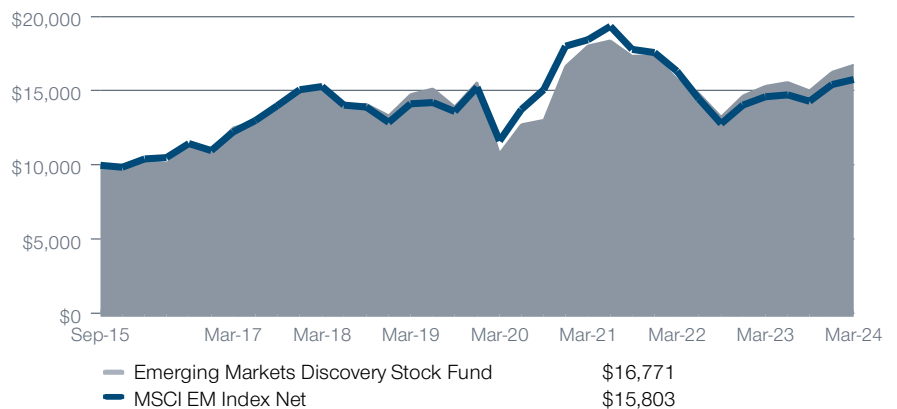
## BENEFITS AND RISKS

The fund offers investors the opportunity for long-term growth of capital through investments in undervalued stocks of companies in emerging markets.

## Definitions

Beta: A measure of market risk of an investment option that shows how responsive the investment is to a given market index, such as the Standard & Poor's 500 Index. By definition, the beta of the benchmark is 1.00. An investment with a beta of 1.10 is expected to perform 10% better than the index in up markets and 10% worse in down markets. Usually, higher betas represent riskier investments. Figures are calculated using monthly data and are net of fees.

Morningstar rated the fund 3 and 3 stars among 721 and 657 Diversified Emerging Mkts funds for the 3- and 5-year periods (as applicable) ending 3/31/2024, respectively. The Morningstar Rating™ for funds, or "star rating", is calculated for funds with at least a three-year history. Exchange-traded funds and open-ended mutual funds are considered a single population for comparative purposes. It is calculated based on a Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a managed product's monthly excess performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. The top 10% of products in each product category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars, and the bottom 10% receive 1 star.
