Seeks to invest in firms with quality management, strength of franchise, reasonable valuation, and strong cash flows.

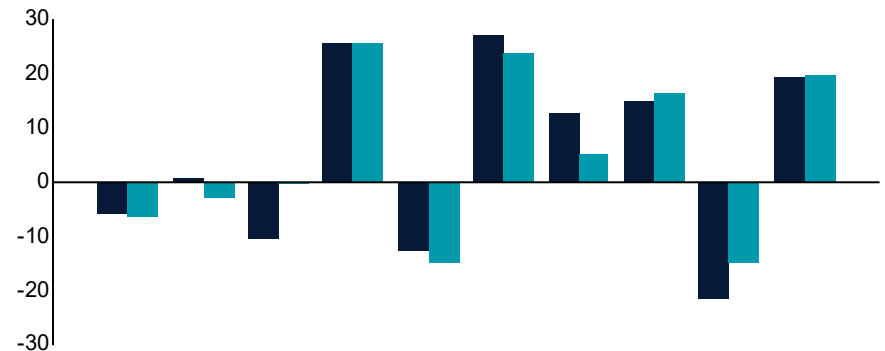
Normally, at least five countries will be represented in the portfolio.

- Primary emphasis: Austria, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, and the United Kingdom.

Expect to make substantially all of its investments in stocks of companies located in the countries listed above, as well as others as their markets develop.

Morningstar rated the fund 3 and 3 stars among 83 and 82 Europe Stock funds for the 3- and 5-year periods (as applicable) ending 6/30/2024, respectively. The Morningstar Rating™ for funds, or "star rating", is calculated for funds with at least a three-year history. Exchange-traded funds and open-ended mutual funds are considered a single population for comparative purposes. It is calculated based on a Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a managed product's monthly excess performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. The top 10% of products in each product category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars, and the bottom 10% receive 1 star.
