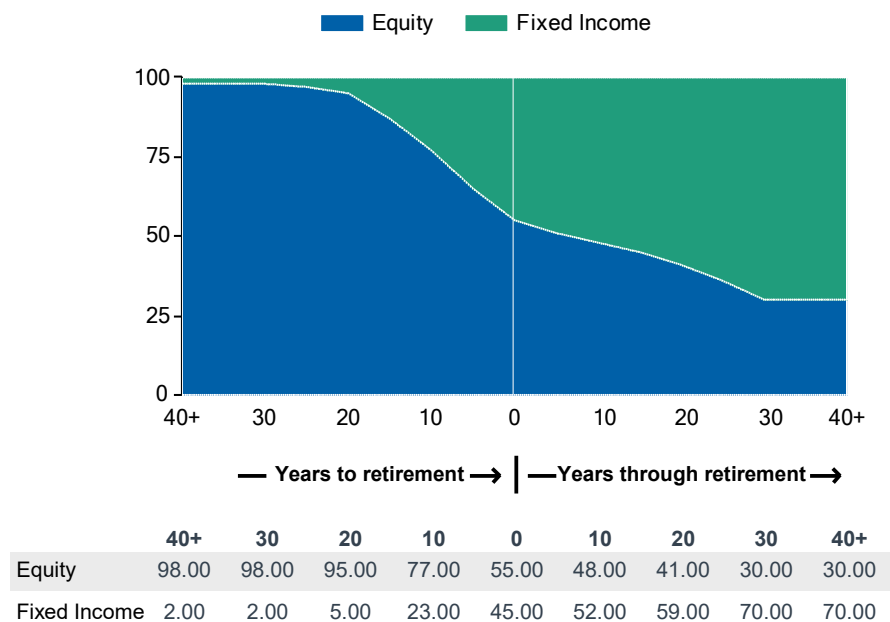
Investment Objective & Strategy

The fund seeks to provide monthly income.

The fund is actively managed and invests in a diversified portfolio of other T. Rowe Price stock and bond funds that represent various asset classes and sectors. The fund's allocation between T. Rowe Price stock and bond funds will change over time in relation to its target retirement date.

The fund is managed based on the specific retirement year, 2020, and assumes a retirement age of 65. It is designed for investors to accumulate assets prior to the target date and also support regular monthly distributions throughout retirement using a managed payout program. It is not designed for a lump sum redemption at the retirement date.
