The fund may invest in companies of any market capitalization, but will generally focus on large- and mid-cap companies.

Our integrated approach to investing combines fundamental analysis and quantitative models to help shape our process for security selection, portfolio construction, and risk management in a systematic manner.

The portfolio is generally constructed by buying higher ranked stocks and selecting stocks to sell from those that have a lower rank, subject to overall risk controls and desired portfolio characteristics.

BENEFITS AND RISKS

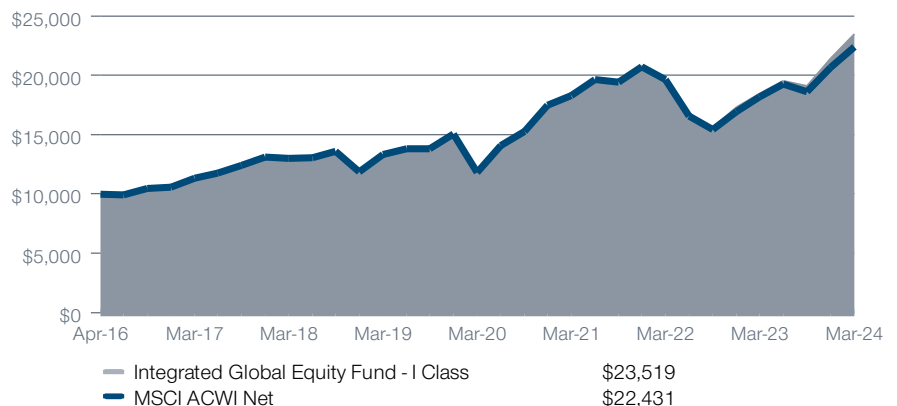
The fund seeks long-term growth of capital through a broadly diversified portfolio of global stocks.

The fund's strategy relies heavily on quantitative models to analyze data and construct investment portfolios which entails risk that the models may be limited, incorrect, or incomplete and may impact the selection of stocks.

Definitions

Beta: A measure of market risk of an investment option that shows how responsive the investment is to a given market index, such as the Standard & Poor's 500 Index. By definition, the beta of the benchmark is 1.00. An investment with a beta of 1.10 is expected to perform 10% better than the index in up markets and 10% worse in down markets. Usually, higher betas represent riskier investments. Figures are calculated using monthly data and are net of fees.

Morningstar rated the fund 5 and 5 stars among 338 and 300 Global Large-Stock Blend funds for the 3- and 5-year periods (as applicable) ending 3/31/2024, respectively. The Morningstar Rating™ for funds, or "star rating", is calculated for funds with at least a three-year history. Exchange-traded funds and open-ended mutual funds are considered a single population for comparative purposes. It is calculated based on a Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a managed product's monthly excess performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. The top 10% of products in each product category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars, and the bottom 10% receive 1 star.

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Unless otherwise noted, index returns are shown with gross dividends reinvested.
