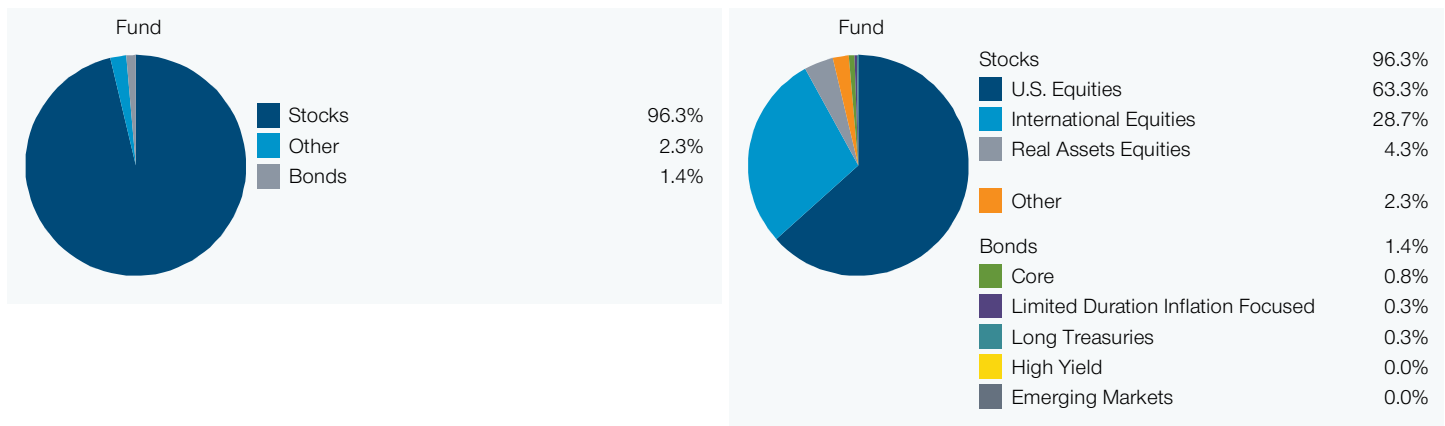

MANAGEMENT

The Retirement Blend Funds are managed by Wyatt Lee, Kim DeDominicis and Andrew Jacobs van Merlen. The portfolio managers are responsible for the strategic design and day-to-day management of the Funds. This includes portfolio design, positioning, performance, and risk-management oversight. The Funds's tactical asset allocation decisions are made by the firm's Asset Allocation Committee. The Committee is co-chaired by Charles Shriver and David Eiswert, and includes some of the firm's most senior investment management professionals across major asset classes. Wyatt is a member of the firm's Asset Allocation Committee. Individual security selection is made by portfolio managers of the Fund's component strategies drawing on the fundamental insights of T. Rowe Price's team of around 200 global research analysts.

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Additional Disclosures
