The fund seeks the highest total return over time consistent with an emphasis on both capital growth and income.


The fund is actively managed and invests in a diversified portfolio of other T. Rowe Price stock and bond funds that represent various asset classes and sectors.



MANAGEMENT

The Retirement I Funds are managed by Wyatt Lee, Kim DeDominicis, and Andrew Jacobs van Merlen. The portfolio managers are responsible for the strategic design and day-to-day management of the Fund. This includes portfolio design, positioning, performance, and risk-management oversight. The Fund's tactical asset allocation decisions are made by the firm's Asset Allocation Committee. The Committee is co-chaired by Charles Shriver and David Eiswert, and includes some of the firm's most senior investment management professionals across major asset classes. Wyatt is a member of the firm's Asset Allocation Committee. Individual security selection is made by portfolio managers of the Fund's component strategies drawing on the fundamental insights of T. Rowe Price's team of around 200 global research analysts.

Morningstar rated the fund 3 and 5 stars among 188 and 175 Target-Date 2050 funds for the 3- and 5-year periods (as applicable) ending 12/31/2023, respectively. The Morningstar Rating™ for funds, or "star rating", is calculated for funds with at least a three-year history. Exchange-traded funds and open-ended mutual funds are considered a single population for comparative purposes. It is calculated based on a Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a managed product's monthly excess performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. The top 10% of products in each product category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars, and the bottom 10% receive 1 star.
