May also invest in bank obligations, collateralized mortgage obligations, foreign securities, and hybrids.

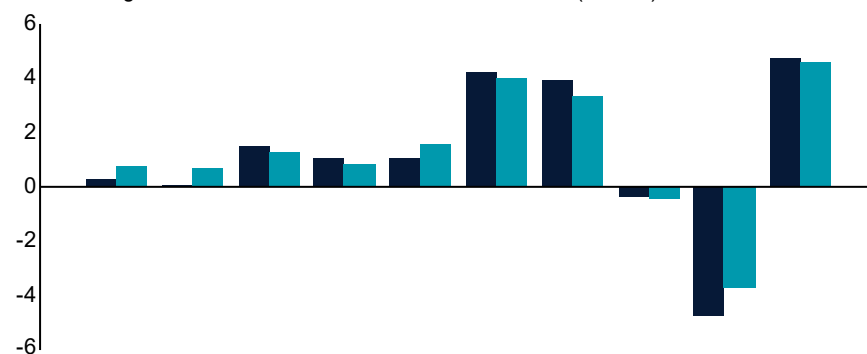
Normally, the fund will invest at least 80% of its net assets in bonds.

Morningstar rated the fund 3, 3, and 2 stars among 522, 482 and 354 Short-Term Bond funds for the 3-, 5-, and 10-year periods (as applicable) ending 6/30/2024, respectively. The Morningstar Rating™ for funds, or "star rating", is calculated for funds with at least a three-year history. Exchange-traded funds and open-ended mutual funds are considered a single population for comparative purposes. It is calculated based on a Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a managed product's monthly excess performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. The top 10% of products in each product category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars, and the bottom 10% receive 1 star.

Fund Assets, holdings-based analytics (excluding portfolio turnover), and portfolio attribution are calculated using T. Rowe Price's internal Investment Book of Records (IBOR).
