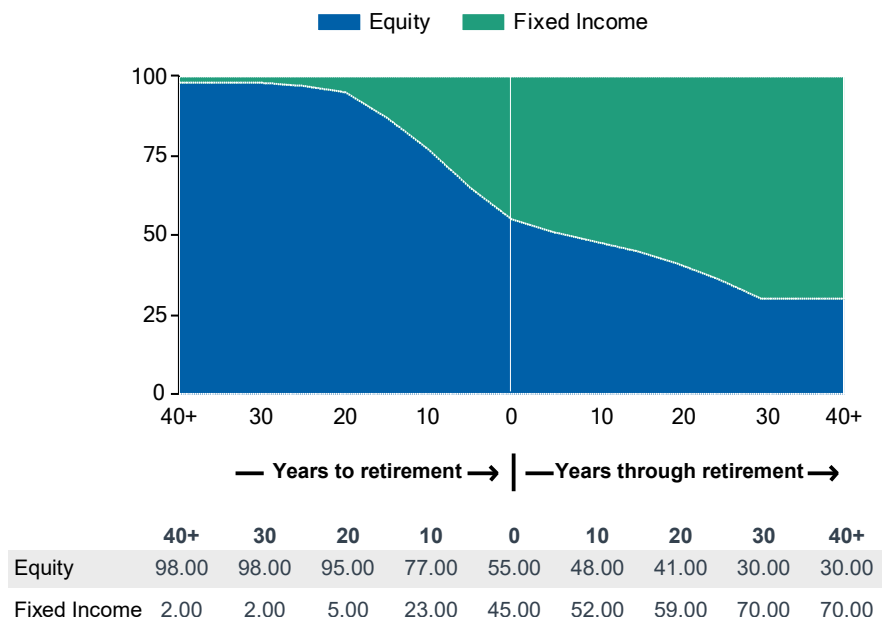
## Investment Objective & Strategy
